

Simucase Chapter Championship Official Rules

1. ELIGIBILITY:

Sweepstakes open to legal residents, age 18 and older, of the United States, its territories and possessions. Entrant must be an undergraduate or graduate student enrolled in a Speech-Language Pathology program at an educational institution in the United States. Employees, officers and directors, and members of their immediate families or of their households (whether related or not), of Sponsor "Simucase, LLC", its affiliated or subsidiary companies, judging agents and promotion partners are not eligible. Sweepstakes is governed by the laws of the U.S.A. Sweepstakes is void where prohibited by law. All applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.

2. ENTRY:

Eligible persons may enter the sweepstakes via the Simucase website, beginning March 20, 2018 and ending April 30, 2018 at 11:59 pm ET. Participants must complete the Joseph case study and receive a $\geq 90\%$ competency score. Participants may complete the case multiple times to achieve a 90% or higher rating, but only one entry per person will be submitted. All participants must provide full name, valid email address and school name in order to be eligible to win. All entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned. Each entry has an equal chance to win. Each NSSLHA chapter is eligible to win one time from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018. In the event of any dispute regarding the identity of an entrant for any online entry, the Authorized Account Holder of the email address used for the entry at the time of entry will be deemed the entrant. "Authorized Account Holder" is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an email address by an internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization (e.g. business, educational institute) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. Sponsor is the official timekeeper for this Sweepstakes. Sponsor, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering with the operation of the entry process.

3. PRIZE:

The top four (4) NSSLHA chapters with the most entries with a score of 90% or higher will each receive a donation of \$250 to their philanthropy. \$1000 total will be awarded. Prizes are non-transferable. All taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the winner.

4. SELECTION OF WINNERS:

Winner will be selected by random drawing from all eligible entries on May 4, 2018 by Sponsor or its judging agent, whose decisions are final in all respects. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. Winners will be notified by email within 30 days of the drawing and may be required to execute a Statement of Eligibility and Release within 30 days of prize notification attempt or winner(s) may be disqualified and prize may be awarded to an alternate winner. Return of prize or prize notification as undeliverable will result in disqualification and an alternate winner may be selected. Entry and/or acceptance of prize(s) constitutes permission for the Sponsor and its agencies and licensees to use any winner's name, address (city and state) and/or likeness for advertising and trade purposes without further compensation or authorization, worldwide and in perpetuity, in any and all forms of media, now known and hereafter devised, unless prohibited by law.

By entering, participants agree to be bound by these complete Official Rules. Any person attempting to defraud or in any way tamper with this Sweepstakes will be ineligible for prizes and may be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. Sponsor reserves the right to terminate or modify the Sweepstakes at any time for any reason. In such circumstances prizes will be awarded based on entries received to date of termination. All prizes will be awarded.
